

Key Verses from the Psalms

Precious Truths, Promises & Prayers

What follows are what I have found to be significant verses among the 150 Psalms. These are certainly not all the important or significant verses, but they are a selection from my own meditation on the Scriptures. It must be noted that some of the Psalms are filled with significant and meaningful verses, but there are a few of the chapters that are difficult to glean any meaningful verses, but I have done my best for I believe that "ALL SCRIPTURE is given by inspiration of God and is PROFITABLE for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness that the man of God may be thoroughly furnished unto good works." (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

The question for most people is what should we do with a list of verses like this? The answer is found in the Psalms themselves. "My <u>meditation</u> of him will be sweet." (Psalm 104:34) "But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law does he <u>meditate</u> day and night." (Psalm 1:2) "When I remember you upon my bed, and <u>meditate</u> on you in the night watches." (Psalm 63:6) "I will <u>meditate</u> also of all your work, and talk of your doings." (Psalm 77:12)

In our age of busyness and rushing about we often do not take time to think, to meditate, to process the Scriptures as we should. A cow not only feeds constantly but he takes time "to chew his cud," that is, he brings it back up to chew on it more throughout the day. We would do well to do the same with the bread of life, the word of God.

May I suggest you employ and discipline and strategy for reading and meditating through the Psalms? I recommend that you take one of these verses each day of the day and make it your meditation. Some of the verses you might want to do more than to think or meditate on them, but you could and should commit your favorites to memory. At the very least you should mark these verses in your own bible so that in future readings your will remember the Word of the Lord.

It is good to remember that that Psalms were often prayers put to music. They were songs and hymns sung to God. You may not be able to sing each Psalm but it is a good thing to at the very least say the verse or verses out loud, and pray the Scriptures back to God. That way the verse is not just information but inspiration for your prayer life.

May the Lord be present as you reflect on these Psalms each and every day.

Psalm 1:1-3

Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night. He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

Psalm 2:8

Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.

Psalm 3:3-5

But you are a shield around me, O LORD; you bestow glory on me and lift up my head. To the LORD I cry aloud, and he answers me from his holy hill. I lie down and sleep; I wake again, because the LORD sustains me.

Psalm 4:3

Know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself; the LORD will hear when I call to him.

Psalm 4: 8

I will lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.

Psalm 5:3

In the morning, O LORD, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait in expectation.

Psalm 5:11

But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rejoice in you.

Psalm 5:12

For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

Psalm 6:2

Be merciful to me, LORD, for I am faint; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are in agony.

Psalm 7:10

My shield is God Most High, who saves the upright in heart.

Psalm 7:17

I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.

Psalm 8:1

O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.

Psalm 8:4-5

What is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor.

Psalm 9:1-2

I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders. I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.

Psalm 9:9-10

The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you.

Psalm 10:1

Why, O LORD, do you stand far off? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble?

Psalm 10:14

But you, O God, do see trouble and grief; you consider it to take it in hand. The victim commits himself to you; you are the helper of the fatherless.

Psalm 11:3-4

When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?" The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his heavenly throne. He observes the sons of men; his eyes examine them.

Psalm 12:6

And the words of the LORD are flawless, like silver refined in a furnace of clay, purified seven times.

Psalm 13:5-6

But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. I will sing to the LORD, for he has been good to me.

Psalm 14:1

The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good.

Psalm 15:1-3

LORD, who may dwell in your sanctuary? Who may live on your holy hill? He whose walk is blameless and who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from his heart and has no slander on his tongue, who does his neighbor no wrong and casts no slur on his fellowman,

Psalm 16:5-8

LORD, you have assigned me my portion and my cup; you have made my lot secure. The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; surely I have a delightful inheritance. I will praise the LORD, who counsels me; even at night my heart instructs me I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

Psalm 17:6

I call on you, O God, for you will answer me; give ear to me and hear my prayer.

Psalm 17:8

Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings

Psalm 18:1-2 I love you, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 18: 30

As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him.

Psalm 19:1-4

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they display knowledge. There is no speech or language where their voice is not heard. Their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world.

Psalm 19: 7-11

The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple. The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes. The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous. They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb. By them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

Psalm 20:1-2

May the LORD answer you when you are in distress;

May the name of the God of Jacob protect you.

May he send you help from the sanctuary and grant you support from Zion.

Psalm 21:7

For the king trusts in the LORD; through the unfailing love of the Most High he will not be shaken.

Psalm 22:19-20

But you, O LORD, be not far off; O my Strength, come quickly to help me. Deliver my life from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dogs.

Psalm 23:1-6

The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters. He restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Psalm 24:3-4

Who may ascend the hill of the LORD? Who may stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to an idol or swear by what is false.

Psalm 25:1-2

To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul; in you I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.

Psalm 25:4-5

Show me your ways, O LORD, teach me your paths; 5. guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.

Psalm 26:2

Test me, O LORD, and try me, examine my heart and my mind;

Psalm 26: 8

I love the house where you live, O LORD, the place where your glory dwells.

Psalm 27:4

One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.

Psalm 27:13-14

I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.

Psalm 28:7-8

The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song. The LORD is the strength of his people, a fortress of salvation for his anointed one.

Psalm 29:1-2

Ascribe to the LORD, O mighty ones, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.

Psalm 30:4-5

Sing to the LORD, you saints of his; praise his holy name. For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favor lasts a lifetime; weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning.

Psalm 31:2-3

Turn your ear to me, come quickly to my rescue; be my rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save me. Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of your name lead and guide me.

Psalm 32:1-2

Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man whose sin the LORD does not count against him and in whose spirit is no deceit.

Psalm 32:7

You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance.

Psalm 32:8-9

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you. Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you.

Psalm 33:11

But the plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of his heart through all generations.

Psalm 33:16-17

No king is saved by the size of his army; no warrior escapes by his great strength. A horse is a vain hope for deliverance; despite all its great strength it cannot save.

Psalm 34:1-4

I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips. My soul will boast in the LORD; let the afflicted hear and rejoice. Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt his name together. I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.

Psalm 34:15

The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry;

Psalm 35:22-23

O LORD, you have seen this; be not silent. Do not be far from me, O Lord. Awake, and rise to my defense! Contend for me, my God and Lord.

Psalm 35: 27-28

May those who delight in my vindication shout for joy and gladness; may they always say, "The LORD be exalted, who delights in the well-being of his servant." My tongue will speak of your righteousness and of your praises all day long.

Psalm 36:5

Your love, O LORD, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies.

Psalm 37:4-6

Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun.

Psalm 37:23

If the LORD delights in a man's way, he makes his steps firm;

Psalm 37:25

I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread.

Psalm 38:21-22

O LORD, do not forsake me; be not far from me, O my God. Come quickly to help me, O Lord my Savior.

Psalm 39:4

Show me, O LORD, my life's end and the number of my days; let me know how fleeting is my life.

Psalm 40:1-3

I waited patiently for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD.

Psalm 40:17

Yet I am poor and needy; may the Lord think of me. You are my help and my deliverer; O my God, do not delay.

Psalm 41:1-3

Blessed is he who has regard for the weak; the LORD delivers him in times of trouble. The LORD will protect him and preserve his life; he will bless him in the land. The LORD will sustain him on his sickbed and restore him from his bed of illness.

Psalm 42:1-2

As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God?

Psalm 43:3-4

Send forth your light and your truth, let them guide me; let them bring me to your holy mountain, to the place where you dwell. Then will I go to the altar of God, to God, my joy and my delight. I will praise you with the harp, O God, my God.

Psalm 44:8

In God we make our boast all day long, and we will praise your name forever. **Selah!**

Psalm 45:1

My heart is stirred by a noble theme as I recite my verses for the king; my tongue is the pen of a skillful writer.

Psalm 46:1-3

God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging. Selah!

Psalm 46: 7

The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress.

Psalm 46: 10

"Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

Psalm 47:1

Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with cries of joy.

Psalm 47:6-7

Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth; sing to him a psalm of praise.

Psalm 48:1-2

Great is the LORD, and most worthy of praise, in the city of our God, his holy mountain. It is beautiful in its loftiness, the joy of the whole earth. Like the utmost heights of Zaphon is Mount Zion, the city of the Great King.

Psalm 49:7-8

No man can redeem the life of another or give to God a ransom for him-- the ransom for a life is costly, no payment is ever enough--

Psalm 50:1-3

The Mighty One, God, the LORD, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to the place where it sets. From Zion, perfect in beauty, God shines forth. Our God comes and will not be silent; a fire devours before him, and around him a tempest rages.

Psalm 50:14

Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High,

Psalm 51:10-12

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Psalm 52:8-9

But I am like an olive tree flourishing in the house of God; I trust in God's unfailing love for ever and ever. I will praise you forever for what you have done; in your name I will hope, for your name is good. I will praise you in the presence of your saints.

Psalm 53:1

The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, and their ways are vile; there is no one who does good.

Psalm 54:6-7

I will sacrifice a freewill offering to you; I will praise your name, O LORD, for it is good. For he has delivered me from all my troubles, and my eyes have looked in triumph on my foes.

Psalm 55:22

Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall.

Psalm 56:3-4

When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?

Psalm 57:1-2

Have mercy on me, O God, have mercy on me, for in you my soul takes refuge. I will take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed. I cry out to God Most High, to God, who fulfills [his purpose] for me.

Psalm 58:11

Then men will say, "Surely the righteous still are rewarded; surely there is a God who judges the earth."

Psalm 59:9

O my Strength, I watch for you; you, O God, are my fortress,

Psalm 60:5

Save us and help us with your right hand, that those you love may be delivered.

Psalm 61:3-4

For you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the foe.. I long to dwell in your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of your wings.

Psalm 62:1-2

My soul finds rest in God alone; my salvation comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will never be shaken.

Psalm 62: 11-12

One thing God has spoken, two things have I heard: that you, O God, are strong, and that you, O Lord, are loving. Surely you will reward each person according to what he has done.

Psalm 63:1, 3-4, 7-8

O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

Psalm 63: 3-4

Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.

Psalm 63: 7-8

Because you are my help, I sing in the shadow of your wings. My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.

Psalm 64:10

Let the righteous rejoice in the LORD and take refuge in him; let all the upright in heart praise him!

Psalm 65:11

You crown the year with your bounty, and your carts overflow with abundance.

Psalm 66:1-2

Shout with joy to God, all the earth! Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious!

Psalm 66:18-20

If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; but God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love from me!

Psalm 67:1

May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine upon us,

Psalm 68:4

Sing to God, sing praise to his name, extol him who rides on the clouds -- his name is the LORD-- and rejoice before him.

Psalm 68:19

Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens.

Psalm 69:1-3

Save me, O God, for the waters have come up to my neck. I sink in the miry depths, where there is no foothold. I have come into the deep waters; the floods engulf me. I am worn out calling for help; my throat is parched. My eyes fail, looking for my God.

Psalm 70:4-5

But may all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you; may those who love your salvation always say, "Let God be exalted!" Yet I am poor and needy; come quickly to me, O God. You are my help and my deliverer; O LORD, do not delay.

Psalm 71:9

Do not cast me away when I am old; do not forsake me when my strength is gone.

Psalm 72:18-19

Praise be to the LORD God, the God of Israel, who alone does marvelous deeds. Praise be to his glorious name forever; may the whole earth be filled with his glory. Amen and Amen.

Psalm 73:23-26

Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory. Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you.

Psalm 74:22

Rise up, O God, and defend your cause; remember how fools mock you all day long.

Psalm 75:1

We give thanks to you, O God, we give thanks, for your Name is near; men tell of your wonderful deeds.

Psalm 76:11

Make vows to the LORD your God and fulfill them; let all the neighboring lands bring gifts to the One to be feared.

Psalm 77:7-9, 19

"Will the Lord reject forever? Will he never show his favor again? Has his unfailing love vanished forever? Has his promise failed for all time? Has God forgotten to be merciful? Has he in anger withheld his compassion?"

Psalm 77: 19

Your path led through the sea, your way through the mighty waters, though your footprints were not seen.

Psalm 78:4

We will not hide them from their children; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, his power, and the wonders he has done.

Psalm 79:9

Help us, O God our Savior, for the glory of your name; deliver us and forgive our sins for your name's sake.

Psalm 79:13

Then we your people, the sheep of your pasture, will praise you forever; from generation to generation we will recount your praise.

Psalm 80:3

Restore us, O God; make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved.

Psalm 80:7

Restore us, O God Almighty; make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved.

Psalm 80: 14

Return to us, O God Almighty! Look down from heaven and see! Watch over this vine,

Psalm 80:18-19

Revive us, and we will call on your name. Restore us, O LORD God Almighty; make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved.

Psalm 81:1-2

Sing for joy to God our strength; shout aloud to the God of Jacob! Begin the music, strike the tambourine, play the melodious harp and lyre.

Psalm 81: 10

I am the LORD your God, who brought you up out of Egypt. Open wide your mouth and I will fill it.

Psalm 81:16

But you would be fed with the finest of wheat; with honey from the rock I would satisfy you."

Psalm 82:3-4

Defend the cause of the weak and fatherless; maintain the rights of the poor and oppressed. Rescue the weak and needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.

Psalm 83: 18

O God, do not keep silent; be not quiet, O God, be not still.

Psalm 83:18

Let them know that you, whose name is the LORD-- that you alone are the Most High over all the earth.

Psalm 84:1-3

How lovely is your dwelling place, O LORD Almighty! My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may have her young-- a place near your altar, O LORD Almighty, my King and my God.

Psalm 84:10-11

Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked. For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless.

Psalm 85:1

You showed favor to your land, O LORD; you restored the fortunes of Jacob.

Psalm 85: 6

Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?

Psalm 86:9-10

All the nations you have made will come and worship before you, O Lord; they will bring glory to your name. For you are great and do marvelous deeds; you alone are God.

Psalm 86: 11

Teach me your way, O LORD, and I will walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

Psalm 87:3

Glorious things are said of you, O city of God: Selah!

Psalm 87: 7

As they make music they will sing, "All my fountains are in you."

Psalm 88:1-3

O LORD, the God who saves me, day and night I cry out before you. May my prayer come before you; turn your ear to my cry. For my soul is full of trouble and my life draws near the grave.

Psalm 89:1

I will sing of the LORD's great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations.

Psalm 89:15-16

Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, O LORD. They rejoice in your name all day long; they exult in your righteousness.

Psalm 90:1-2

Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Psalm 90:4

For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night.

Psalm 90: 9-10

All our days pass away under your wrath; we finish our years with a moan. The length of our days is seventy years— or eighty, if we have the strength; yet their span is but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away.

Psalm 90:12

Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.

Psalm 90:17

May the favor of the Lord our God rest upon us; establish the work of our hands for us-- yes, establish the work of our hands.

Psalm 91:1-2

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

Psalm 91: 11-12

For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

Psalm 91: 14-16

"Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."

Psalm 92:12-14

The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; planted in the house of the LORD, they will flourish in the courts of our God. They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green,

Psalm 93:1

The LORD reigns, he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed in majesty and is armed with strength. The world is firmly established; it cannot be moved.

Psalm 93: 5

Your statutes stand firm; holiness adorns your house for endless days, O LORD.

Psalm 94: 17-19

Unless the LORD had given me help, I would soon have dwelt in the silence of death. When I said, "My foot is slipping," your love, O LORD, supported me. When anxiety was great within me, your consolation brought joy to my soul.

Psalm 95:6-7

Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. Today, if you hear his voice,

Psalm 96:1-2, 7-9

Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. Sing to the LORD, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day.

Psalm 96: 7-9

Ascribe to the LORD, O families of nations, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts.

Psalm 97:1

The LORD reigns, let the earth be glad; let the distant shores rejoice.

Psalm 97:11-12

Light is shed upon the righteous and joy on the upright in heart. Rejoice in the LORD, you who are righteous, and praise his holy name.

Psalm 98:1

Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him.

Psalm 98:4-6

Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth, burst into jubilant song with music; make music to the LORD with the harp, with the harp and the sound of singing, with trumpets and the blast of the ram's horn-- shout for joy before the LORD, the King.

Psalm 99:2-3
