Concordance & Word Studies

We know that many of our readers are not students of the Word, but we want to encourage you to get deeper into the Word of God and not depend on what others tell you it means. There is no better way to dig deeper than to do word studies. Take a good concordance of the Bible that lists the reference to every word used in the Bible and track its usage in each context. Strong's Concordance is the best because every word is given a number. This will help to give you a better idea of the concept God was conveying in naming Himself or His Son by this title or name. We have given the key word with Strong's numbering system. We know this is time consuming, but what better use of your time than to soak your mind in the Word of God.

Bible Study groups can utilize this method to enhance their understanding of the title and then discuss it with other meaningful passages that support that concept. We have deliberately not listed all the passages or references to save on space, but when you study please do not take short-cuts. Look up every passage. It will help you get a better feel for the words and concepts.

Concordance of Hebrew Names

1. Almighty God - Omnipotent<07706>

Obviously the "Omni" words are not biblical words but they represent biblical concepts. Here the concept is that God is all-powerful. A good theology book of the characteristics of God would be a help. There are many such passages. There are 48 God Almighty or Almighty passages

- Genesis 17:1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty $\leq 0.07706 \geq 0.00$ God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

2. Ancient of Days < 06268>

Search not only the words but the concepts the words convey; "forever," "everlasting," and "no end," might help your understanding of God's endlessness. etc.

- Psalms 90:4 For a thousand <u>years</u> in thy sight *are but* as yesterday when it is past, and *as* a watch in the night.
- Psalms 90:2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from <u>everlasting to everlasting</u>, thou *art* God.
- Psalms 103:17 But the mercy of the LORD *is* from <u>everlasting to everlasting</u> upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;
- Psalms 106:48 Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel from <u>everlasting</u> to <u>everlasting</u>: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye the LORD.
- Daniel 7:9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment *was* white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne *was like* the fiery flame, *and* his wheels *as* burning fire.
- Daniel 7:13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, *one* like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the <u>Ancient of days</u>, and they brought him near before him.

3. Anointed One < 04899>

There are 38 references to anointed in the Bible. The concept of Messiah is also "the anointed one." Here are a few to start your study.

- Leviticus 4:3 If the priest that is anointed <04899> do sin according to the sin of the people; then let him bring for his sin, which he hath sinned, a young bullock without blemish unto the LORD for a sin offering.
- Leviticus 4:5 And the priest that is anointed <04899> shall take of the bullock's blood, and bring it to the tabernacle of the congregation:
- Leviticus 4:16 And the priest that is anointed <u><04899></u> shall bring of the bullock's blood to the tabernacle of the congregation:
- Leviticus 6:22 And the priest of his sons that is anointed <04899> in his stead shall offer it: *it is* a statute for ever unto the LORD; it shall be wholly burnt.
- 1 Samuel 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed <04899>.
- 1 Samuel 2:35 And I will raise me up a faithful priest, *that* shall do according to *that* which *is* in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed <04899> for ever.
- 1 Samuel 12:3 Behold, here I *am*: witness against me before the LORD, and before his anointed <04899>: whose ox have I taken? or whose ass have I taken? or whom have I defrauded? whom have I oppressed? or of whose hand have I received *any* bribe to blind mine eyes therewith? and I will restore it you.
- 1 Samuel 12:5 And he said unto them, The LORD *is* witness against you, and his anointed <04899> *is* witness this day, that ye have not found ought in my hand. And they answered, *He is* witness.
- 1 Samuel 16:6 And it came to pass, when they were come, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD'S anointed <04899> is before him.
- 1 Samuel 24:6 And he said unto his men, The LORD forbid that I should do this thing unto my master, the LORD'S anointed <04899>, to stretch forth mine hand against him, seeing he *is* the anointed <04899> of the LORD.

- 1 Samuel 24:10 Behold, this day thine eyes have seen how that the LORD had delivered thee to day into mine hand in the cave: and *some* bade *me* kill thee: but *mine eye* spared thee; and I said, I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he *is* the LORD'S anointed ≤04899>.
- 1 Samuel 26:9 And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed <04899>, and be guiltless?
- 1 Samuel 26:11 The LORD forbid that I should stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed <04899>: but, I pray thee, take thou now the spear that *is* at his bolster, and the cruse of water, and let us go.
- 1 Samuel 26:16 This thing *is* not good that thou hast done. *As* the LORD liveth, ye *are* worthy to die, because ye have not kept your master, the LORD'S anointed (04899>. And now see where the king's spear *is*, and the cruse of water that *was* at his bolster.
- 1 Samuel 26:23 The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his faithfulness: for the LORD delivered thee into *my* hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed <04899>.
- 2 Samuel 1:14 And David said unto him, How wast thou not afraid to stretch forth thine hand to destroy the LORD'S anointed <04899>?
- 2 Samuel 1:16 And David said unto him, Thy blood *be* upon thy head; for thy mouth hath testified against thee, saying, I have slain the LORD'S anointed <04899>.
- 2 Samuel 1:21 Ye mountains of Gilboa, *let there be* no dew, neither *let there be* rain, upon you, nor fields of offerings: for there the shield of the mighty is vilely cast away, the shield of Saul, *as though he had* not *been* anointed <04899> with oil.
- 2 Samuel 19:21 But Abishai the son of Zeruiah answered and said, Shall not Shimei be put to death for this, because he cursed the LORD'S anointed <04899>?
- 2 Samuel 22:51 *He is* the tower of salvation for his king: and sheweth mercy to his anointed <04899>, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.
- 2 Samuel 23:1 Now these *be* the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man *who was* raised up on high, the anointed <u><04899></u> of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,
- 1 Chronicles 16:22 Saying, Touch not mine anointed <04899>, and do my prophets no harm
- 2 Chronicles 6:42 O LORD God, turn not away the face of thine anointed <04899>: remember the mercies of David thy servant.
- Psalms 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed <04899>, saying,
- Psalms 18:50 Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and sheweth mercy to his anointed <04899>, to David, and to his seed for evermore.
- Psalms 20:6 Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed <04899>; he will hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand.
- Psalms 28:8 The LORD is their strength, and he is the saving strength of his anointed <04899>.
- Psalms 84:9 Behold, O God our shield, and look upon the face of thine anointed <04899>.
- Psalms 89:38 But thou hast cast off and abhorred, thou hast been wroth with thine anointed <04899>.
- Psalms 89:51 Wherewith thine enemies have reproached, O LORD; wherewith they have reproached the footsteps of thine anointed <04899>.
- Psalms 105:15 Saying, Touch not mine anointed <04899>, and do my prophets no harm.
- Psalms 132:10 For thy servant David's sake turn not away the face of thine anointed <04899>.
- Psalms 132:17 There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed <04899>.

- Isaiah 45:1 Thus saith the LORD to his anointed <04899>, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;
- Lamentations 4:20 The breath of our nostrils, the anointed <04899> of the LORD, was taken in their pits, of whom we said, Under his shadow we shall live among the heathen.
- Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, *that* from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah <04899> the Prince *shall be* seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.
- Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah <04899> be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof *shall be* with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

4. Everlasting Father <05703>, <01>

There are 91 references to "everlasting" which is a wonderful study in itself. We have traces just a few here.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Psalms 90:2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from <u>everlasting to everlasting</u>, thou *art* God.

Psalms 103:17 But the mercy of the LORD *is* from <u>everlasting</u> to <u>everlasting</u> upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children;

Psalms 106:48 Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel from <u>everlasting</u> to <u>everlasting</u>: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye the LORD.

5. I AM <01961>

The "I AM" as a name of God is introduced to Moses in Exodus. It is a common verb of "To be" therefore a search of the verb is not helpful. We have restricted our search to its use as a name for the Lord.

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, <u>I AM THAT I AM</u>: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

John 6:48 I am that bread of life.

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, <u>Before Abraham was</u>, I am.

John 10:9 \underline{I} am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

6. Omniscient <02451>

Obviously the "Omni" words are not biblical words but they represent biblical concepts. Here the concept is that God is all-knowing. There are many such passages. A good theology book of the characteristics of God would be a help. It is also translated as "wisdom."

Job 37:16 Dost thou know the balancings of the clouds, the wondrous works of him which is perfect in knowledge?

- Psalms 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
- Psalms 37:18 The LORD knoweth the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever.
- Psalms 94:11 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity.
- Isaiah 40:13 Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or *being* his counsellor hath taught him?
- Isaiah 55:8 For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD. 9 For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- Daniel 4:35 And all the inhabitants of the earth *are* reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and *among* the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?

7. Omnipresent <04672>

Obviously the "Omni" words are not biblical words but they represent biblical concepts. Here the concept is that God is all-present. A good theology book of the characteristics of God would be a help. There are many such passages.

Psalms 139:1-21

- 1 O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me.
- 2 Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off
- 3 Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways.
- 4 For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.
- 5 Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.
- 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it.
- 7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
- 8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou *art* there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou *art* there.
- 9 If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;
- 10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.
- 11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.
- 12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light *are* both alike *to thee*.
- 13 For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.
- 14 I will praise thee; for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made: marvellous *are* thy works; and *that* my soul knoweth right well.
- 15 My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, *and* curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.
- 16 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all *my members* were written, *which* in continuance were fashioned, when *as yet there was* none of them.
- 17 How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!
- 18 If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.
- 19 Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men.
- 20 For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain.
- 21 Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee?

8. Omnipotent < 04672>

Omnipotent is not used as a word to describe God or his name but it is a uniquely identifying character of God alone. El Shaddai is the Hebrew name for God that encapsulates this name and character. Look for verses that declare the mighty power of God.

"To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal?" says the Holy One. Lift your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name. Because of his **great power and mighty strength**, not one of them is missing. – Isaiah 40:25-26

- Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, <u>The</u> <u>mighty God</u>, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.
- Psalms 147:5 Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite.
- Jeremiah 32:17 Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, *and* there is nothing too hard for thee:
- Jeremiah 3227 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?

9. Prince of Peace < 08269>

That was easy! Look for Scriptures that attribute "peace" to the Lord.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The <u>Prince of Peace</u>.

Luke 1:79 To give light to them that sit in darkness and *in* the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Luke 10:6 And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again.

Luke 14:32 Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth conditions of peace.

Romans 3:17 And the way of peace have they not known:

Romans 10:15 And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

Romans 15:33 Now the God of peace be with you all. Amen.

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not *the author* of confusion, but <u>of peace</u>, as in all churches of the saints.

Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Ephesians 6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Philippians 4:9 Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

10. Savior <03467>

- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my <u>saviour</u>; thou savest me from violence.
- 2 Kings 13:5 (And the LORD gave Israel a <u>saviour</u>, so that they went out from under the hand of the Syrians: and the children of Israel dwelt in their tents, as beforetime.
- Psalms 106:21 They forgat God their <u>saviour</u>, which had done great things in Egypt; Isaiah 19:20 And it shall be for a sign and for a witness unto the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt: for they shall cry unto the LORD because of the oppressors, and he shall send them a <u>saviour</u>, and a great one, and he shall deliver them.
- Isaiah 43:3 For I *am* the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy <u>Saviour</u>: I gave Egypt *for* thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.
- Isaiah 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour.
- Isaiah 45:15 Verily thou art a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour.
- Isaiah 45:21 Tell ye, and bring *them* near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? *who* hath told it from that time? *have* not I the LORD? and *there is* no God else beside me; a just God and a <u>Saviour</u>; *there is* none beside me.
- Isaiah 49:26 And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD *am* thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.
- Isaiah 60:16 Thou shalt also suck the milk of the Gentiles, and shalt suck the breast of kings: and thou shalt know that I the LORD *am* thy <u>Saviour</u> and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.
- Isaiah 63:8 For he said, Surely they *are* my people, children *that* will not lie: so he was their <u>Saviour</u>.
- Jeremiah 14:8 O the hope of Israel, the <u>saviour</u> thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man *that* turneth aside to tarry for a night?

Yeshua (Jesus) <03091>

The name Yeshua is translated Joshua. There are 199 references to the name Joshua. Have fun searching for Yeshua that refers to Messiah that is yet to come. Look for similarities between the work of Joshua and that of Jesus. The name is translated to Jesus in the New Testament. The name of Jesus appears 942 times in the New Testament (2424 Jesus).

- Matthew 1:1 The book of the generation of <u>Jesus</u> Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham
- Matthew 1:16 And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born <u>Jesus</u>, who is called Christ.
- Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of <u>Jesus</u> Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name <u>JESUS</u>: for he shall save his people from their sins.

11. Fortress < 04686>

1 Samuel 22:4 And he brought them before the king of Moab: and they dwelt with him all the while that David was in the hold <04686>.

- 1 Samuel 22:5 And the prophet Gad said unto David, Abide not in the hold <04686>; depart, and get thee into the land of Judah. Then David departed, and came into the forest of Hareth.
- 1 Samuel 24:22 And David sware unto Saul. And Saul went home; but David and his men gat them up unto the hold <04686>.
- 2 Samuel 5:7 Nevertheless David took the strong hold <04686> of Zion: the same *is* the city of David.
- 2 Samuel 5:9 So David dwelt in the fort <04686>, and called it the city of David. And David built round about from Millo and inward.
- 2 Samuel 5:17 But when the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines came up to seek David; and David heard *of it*, and went down to the hold <04686>.
- 2 Samuel 22:2 And he said, The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress <04686>, and my deliverer;
- 2 Samuel 23:14 And David *was* then in an hold <u><04686></u>, and the garrison of the Philistines *was* then *in* Bethlehem.
- 1 Chronicles 11:5 And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle <04686> of Zion, which is the city of David.

12. High Tower < 04869>

- Psalms 9:9 The LORD also will be a refuge <04869> for the oppressed, a refuge <04869> in times of trouble.
- Psalms 18:2 The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower <04869>.
- Psalms 46:7 The LORD of hosts *is* with us; the God of Jacob *is* our refuge <04869>. Selah.
- Psalms 46:11 The LORD of hosts *is* with us; the God of Jacob *is* our refuge <04869>.
- Psalms 48:3 God is known in her palaces for a refuge <04869>.
- Psalms 59:9 *Because of* his strength will I wait upon thee: for God *is* my defence <04869>.
- Psalms 59:16 But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defence <04869> and refuge in the day of my trouble.

13. Sabaoth < 06635>

There are 463 references to "sabaoth" which by the way has nothing to do with "Sabbath." It is a military term referring to "armies" or "troops."

- Isaiah 1:9 Except the LORD of hosts had left unto us a very small remnant, we should have been as Sodom, *and* we should have been like unto Gomorrah.
- Romans 9:29 And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of <u>Sabaoth</u> had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha.
- James 5:4 Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of <u>sabaoth</u>.

14. Horn of Salvation < 07161>

- 1 Samuel 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed.
- 1 Samuel 16:13 Then Samuel took the <u>horn of</u> oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.
- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: *he is* my shield, and the <u>horn of</u> my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence
- 1 Kings 1:39 And Zadok the priest took an <u>horn of</u> oil out of the tabernacle, and anointed Solomon. And they blew the trumpet; and all the people said, God save king Solomon.
- Psalms 18:2 The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the **horn of my salvation**, *and* my high tower.
- Psalms 92:10 But my horn shalt thou exalt like *the <u>horn</u> of* an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.
- Psalms 132:17 There will I make the <u>horn</u> of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed.
- Psalms 148:14 He also exalteth the <u>horn of</u> his people, the praise of all his saints; *even* of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.
- Jeremiah 48:25 The horn of Moab is cut off, and his arm is broken, saith the LORD.

15. Rear Guard <0622>

There are 187references to "rear guard" but for our purposes look for "rereward."

- Numbers 10:25 And the standard of the camp of the children of Dan set forward, *which* was the <u>rereward</u> of all the camps throughout their hosts: and over his host was Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.
- Joshua 6:9 And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the <u>rereward</u> came after the ark, *the priests* going on, and blowing with the trumpets.
- Joshua 6:13 And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the <u>rereward</u> came after the ark of the LORD, *the priests* going on, and blowing with the trumpets.
- 1 Samuel 29:2 And the lords of the Philistines passed on by hundreds, and by thousands: but David and his men passed on in the rereward with Achish.
- Isaiah 52:12 For ye shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight: for the LORD will go before you; and the God of Israel *will be* your <u>rereward</u>.
- Isaiah 58:8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy <u>rereward</u>.

16. Hiding Place <05643>

Remember that "hiding place" is a concept and not just a word to be translated. Any reference to the Lord's overshadowing protection is a valid reference to his "hiding place" or the "secret place" of the Most High.

- Deuteronomy 27:15 Cursed *be* the man that maketh *any* graven or molten image, an abomination unto the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and putteth *it* in *a* secret \leq 05643 \geq *place*. And all the people shall answer and say, Amen.
- Deuteronomy 27:24 Cursed be he that smiteth his neighbour secretly $\leq 0.05643 \geq$. And all the people shall say, Amen.
- Deuteronomy 28:57 And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all *things* secretly <05643> in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.
- Deuteronomy 32:38 Which did eat the fat of their sacrifices, *and* drank the wine of their drink offerings? let them rise up and help you, *and* be your protection <05643>.
- Judges 3:19 But he himself turned again from the quarries that *were* by Gilgal, and said, I have a secret <05643> errand unto thee, O king: who said, Keep silence. And all that stood by him went out from him.
- 1 Samuel 19:2 But Jonathan Saul's son delighted much in David: and Jonathan told David, saying, Saul my father seeketh to kill thee: now therefore, I pray thee, take heed to thyself until the morning, and abide in a secret <05643> place, and hide thyself:
- 1 Samuel 25:20 And it was *so*, *as* she rode on the ass, that she came down by the covert <o href="eq056433"><o href="eq066433"><o hr
- 2 Samuel 12:12 For thou didst *it* secretly <05643>: but I will do this thing before all Israel, and before the sun.
- Job 13:10 He will surely reprove you, if ye do secretly <05643> accept persons.
- Job 22:14 Thick clouds *are* a covering <u><05643></u> to him, that he seeth not; and he walketh in the circuit of heaven.
- Job 24:15 The eye also of the adulterer waiteth for the twilight, saying, No eye shall see me: and disguiseth <05643> his face.
- Job 31:27 And my heart hath been secretly <u><05643></u> enticed, or my mouth hath kissed my hand:
- Job 40:21 He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert <0.5643> of the reed, and fens.

 Psalms 18:11 He made darkness his secret place <0.5643>; his payilion round about his
- Psalms 18:11 He made darkness his secret place <05643>; his pavilion round about him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies.
- Psalms 27:5 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret <a href="eq: 05643"
- Psalms 31:20 Thou shalt hide them in the secret <05643> of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.
- Psalms 32:7 Thou *art* my hiding place <05643>; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.
- Psalms 61:4 I will abide in thy tabernacle for ever: I will trust in the covert <05643> of thy wings. Selah.
- Psalms 81:7 Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place <05643> of thunder: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah.

- Psalms 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret <05643> place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- Psalms 101:5 Whoso privily <05643 slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer.
- Psalms 119:114 Thou art my hiding place <05643> and my shield: I hope in thy word.
- Psalms 139:15 My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret <0.5643>, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.
- Proverbs 9:17 Stolen waters are sweet, and bread *eaten* in secret <05643> is pleasant. Proverbs 21:14 A gift in secret <05643> pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom
- strong wrath.
- Proverbs 25:23 The north wind driveth away rain: so *doth* an angry countenance a backbiting <05643> tongue.
- Song of Solomon 2:14 O my dove, *that art* in the clefts of the rock, in the secret <a href="e
- Isaiah 16:4 Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert <05643> to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceaseth, the oppressors are consumed out of the land.
- Isaiah 28:17 Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place <05643>.
- Isaiah 32:2 And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert <0.5643> from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.
- Isaiah 45:19 I have not spoken in secret <0.5643>, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.
- Isaiah 48:16 Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret <05643> from the beginning; from the time that it was, there *am* I: and now the Lord GOD, and his Spirit, hath sent me.
- Jeremiah 37:17 Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king asked him secretly <05643> in his house, and said, Is there *any* word from the LORD? And Jeremiah said, There is: for, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon.

17. Refuge (hideaway) <04585>

- Deuteronomy 33:27 The eternal God *is thy* refuge <04585>, and underneath *are* the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy *them*.
- Job 37:8 Then the beasts go into dens, and remain in their places $\leq 0.4585 >$.
- Job 38:40 When they couch in *their* dens <u><04585></u>, and abide in the covert to lie in wait? Psalms 76:2 In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place <04585> in Zion.
- Psalms 104:22 The sun ariseth, they gather themselves together, and lay them down in their dens <04585>.

- Song of Solomon 4:8 Come with me from Lebanon, *my* spouse, with me from Lebanon: look from the top of Amana, from the top of Shenir and Hermon, from the lions' dens <04585>, from the mountains of the leopards.
- Jeremiah 21:13 Behold, I *am* against thee, O inhabitant of the valley, *and* rock of the plain, saith the LORD; which say, Who shall come down against us? or who shall enter into our habitations <04585>?
- Amos 3:4 Will a lion roar in the forest, when he hath no prey? will a young lion cry out of his den <04585>, if he have taken nothing?

18. Refuge (escape) <04498>

- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: *he is* my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge <04498>, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.
- Job 11:20 But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape $\leq 0.04498 \geq$, and their hope *shall be as* the giving up of the ghost.
- Psalms 59:16 But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defence and refuge <04498> in the day of my trouble.
- Psalms 142:4 I looked on *my* right hand, and beheld, but *there was* no man that would know me: refuge <04498> failed me; no man cared for my soul.
- Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge <04498> in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and *things* wherein *there is* no profit.
- Jeremiah 25:35 And the shepherds shall have no way <04498> to flee, nor the principal of the flock to escape.
- Jeremiah 46:5 Wherefore have I seen them dismayed *and* turned away back? and their mighty ones are beaten down, and are fled apace <04498>, and look not back: *for* fear *was* round about, saith the LORD.
- Amos 2:14 Therefore the flight <u>04498</u> shall perish from the swift, and the strong shall not strengthen his force, neither shall the mighty deliver himself:

19. Shield <06793>

It is interesting to note the difficulties translators faced in rendering the exact and consistent meaning of words. Shield is just such a case. Not Psalm 5:12 and contrast it with Psalm 32:2 and Psalm 91. They seem to have used the two words for shield interchangeably.

- 1 Samuel 17:7 And the staff of his spear *was* like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head *weighed* six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield <06793> went before him
- 1 Samuel 17:41 And the Philistine came on and drew near unto David; and the man that bare the shield <06793> went before him.
- 1 Kings 10:16 And king Solomon made two hundred targets $\leq 0.06793 \geq of$ beaten gold: six hundred *shekels* of gold went to one target $\leq 0.06793 \geq of$.
- 1 Chronicles 12:8 And of the Gadites there separated themselves unto David into the hold to the wilderness men of might, *and* men of war *fit* for the battle, that could handle shield <06793> and buckler, whose faces *were like* the faces of lions, and *were* as swift as the roes upon the mountains;
- 1 Chronicles 12:24 The children of Judah that bare shield <u><06793></u> and spear *were* six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed to the war.

- 1 Chronicles 12:34 And of Naphtali a thousand captains, and with them with shield <a href
- 2 Chronicles 9:15 And king Solomon made two hundred targets <06793> of beaten gold: six hundred *shekels* of beaten gold went to one target <06793>.
- 2 Chronicles 11:12 And in every several city *he put* shields <u><06793></u> and spears, and made them exceeding strong, having Judah and Benjamin on his side.
- 2 Chronicles 14:8 And Asa had an army *of men* that bare targets <06793> and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these *were* mighty men of valour.
- 2 Chronicles 25:5 Moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together, and made them captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, according to the houses of *their* fathers, throughout all Judah and Benjamin: and he numbered them from twenty years old and above, and found them three hundred thousand choice *men*, *able* to go forth to war, that could handle spear and shield <06793>.
- Psalms 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as *with* a shield <06793>.
- Psalms 35:2 Take hold of shield and buckler <06793>, and stand up for mine help. Psalms 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield <06793> and buckler.
- Proverbs 25:13 As the cold <06793> of snow in the time of harvest, *so is* a faithful messenger to them that send him: for he refresheth the soul of his masters.
- Jeremiah 46:3 Order ye the buckler and shield <06793>, and draw near to battle.
- Ezekiel 23:24 And they shall come against thee with chariots, wagons, and wheels, and with an assembly of people, *which* shall set against thee buckler <06793> and shield and helmet round about: and I will set judgment before them, and they shall judge thee according to their judgments.
- Ezekiel 26:8 He shall slay with the sword thy daughters in the field: and he shall make a fort against thee, and cast a mount against thee, and lift up the buckler <06793> against thee.
- Ezekiel 38:4 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of armour, even a great company with bucklers <06793> and shields, all of them handling swords:
- Ezekiel 39:9 And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers <06793>, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:
- Amos 4:2 The Lord GOD hath sworn by his holiness, that, lo, the days shall come upon you, that he will take you away with hooks <06793>, and your posterity with fishhooks.

20. Shield <04043>

There are 60 references to the 04043 shield in the Old Testament. Restrict your study to the Psalms and you get a good idea of it's use.

- Psalms 3:3 But thou, O LORD, *art* a shield <04043> for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.
- Psalms 7:10 My defence <04043> is of God, which saveth the upright in heart.

- Deuteronomy 14:27 And the Levite that *is* within thy gates; thou shalt not forsake him; for he hath no part <02506> nor inheritance with thee.
- Deuteronomy 14:29 And the Levite, (because he hath no part <02506> nor inheritance with thee,) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which *are* within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.
- Deuteronomy 18:1 The priests the Levites, *and* all the tribe of Levi, shall have no part <u><02506</u> nor inheritance with Israel: they shall eat the offerings of the LORD made by fire, and his inheritance.
- Deuteronomy 18:8 They shall have like portions <u><02506></u> to eat, beside that which cometh of the sale of his patrimony.
- Deuteronomy 32:9 For the LORD'S portion <02506> is his people; Jacob is the lot of his inheritance.
- Joshua 14:4 For the children of Joseph were two tribes, Manasseh and Ephraim: therefore they gave no part <02506> unto the Levites in the land, save cities to dwell *in*, with their suburbs for their cattle and for their substance.
- Joshua 15:13 And unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh he gave a part <02506> among the children of Judah, according to the commandment of the LORD to Joshua, *even* the city of Arba the father of Anak, which *city is* Hebron.
- Joshua 18:5 And they shall divide it into seven parts <02506>: Judah shall abide in their coast on the south, and the house of Joseph shall abide in their coasts on the north.
- Joshua 18:6 Ye shall therefore describe the land *into* seven parts <02506>, and bring *the* description hither to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God.
- Joshua 18:7 But the Levites have no part <02506> among you; for the priesthood of the LORD *is* their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them.
- Joshua 18:9 And the men went and passed through the land, and described it by cities into seven parts <02506> in a book, and came *again* to Joshua to the host at Shiloh.
- Joshua 19:9 Out of the portion of the children of Judah *was* the inheritance of the children of Simeon: for the part <02506> of the children of Judah was too much for them: therefore the children of Simeon had their inheritance within the inheritance of them.
- Joshua 22:25 For the LORD hath made Jordan a border between us and you, ye children of Reuben and children of Gad; ye have no part <02506≥ in the LORD: so shall your children make our children cease from fearing the LORD.
- Joshua 22:27 But *that* it *may be* a witness between us, and you, and our generations after us, that we might do the service of the LORD before him with our burnt offerings,

- and with our sacrifices, and with our peace offerings; that your children may not say to our children in time to come, Ye have no part $\leq 0.2506 \geq$ in the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 30:24 For who will hearken unto you in this matter? but as his part <02506> is that goeth down to the battle, so *shall* his part <02506> be that tarrieth by the stuff: they shall part alike.
- 2 Samuel 20:1 And there happened to be there a man of Belial, whose name *was* Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part <02506> in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.
- 1 Kings 12:16 So when all Israel saw that the king hearkened not unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion <02506> have we in David? neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: to your tents, O Israel: now see to thine own house, David. So Israel departed unto their tents.
- 2 Kings 9:10 And the dogs shall eat Jezebel in the portion <02506> of Jezreel, and *there shall be* none to bury *her*. And he opened the door, and fled.
- 2 Kings 9:36 Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This *is* the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion <a href="mailto:s
- 2 Kings 9:37 And the carcase of Jezebel shall be as dung upon the face of the field in the portion <02506> of Jezreel; so that they shall not say, This is Jezebel.
- 2 Chronicles 10:16 And when all Israel *saw* that the king would not hearken unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion <02506> have we in David? and *we have* none inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to your tents, O Israel: *and* now, David, see to thine own house. So all Israel went to their tents.
- Nehemiah 2:20 Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion <02506>, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.
- Job 17:5 He that speaketh flattery <02506> to his friends, even the eyes of his children shall fail.
- Job 20:29 This *is* the portion <02506> of a wicked man from God, and the heritage appointed unto him by God.
- Job 27:13 This *is* the portion <02506> of a wicked man with God, and the heritage of oppressors, *which* they shall receive of the Almighty.
- Job 31:2 For what portion <02506> of God is there from above? and what inheritance of the Almighty from on high?
- Job 32:17 *I said*, I will answer also my part <02506>, I also will shew mine opinion.
- Psalms 16:5 The LORD *is* the portion of mine inheritance <02506> and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.
- Psalms 17:14 From men *which are* thy hand, O LORD, from men of the world, *which have* their portion <u><02506></u> in *this* life, and whose belly thou fillest with thy hid *treasure*: they are full of children, and leave the rest of their *substance* to their babes.
- Psalms 50:18 When thou sawest a thief, then thou consentedst with him, and hast been partaker <02506> with adulterers.
- Psalms 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: *but* God *is* the strength of my heart, and my portion <02506> for ever.
- Psalms 119:57 CHETH. *Thou art* my portion <02506>, O LORD: I have said that I would keep thy words.
- Psalms 142:5 I cried unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou *art* my refuge *and* my portion <02506> in the land of the living.
- Proverbs 7:21 With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering <02506> of her lips she forced him.
- Ecclesiastes 2:10 And whatsoever mine eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my heart from any joy; for my heart rejoiced in all my labour: and this was my portion <02506> of all my labour.

- Ecclesiastes 2:21 For there is a man whose labour *is* in wisdom, and in knowledge, and in equity; yet to a man that hath not laboured therein shall he leave it *for* his portion <02506>. This also *is* vanity and a great evil.
- Ecclesiastes 3:22 Wherefore I perceive that *there is* nothing better, than that a man should rejoice in his own works; for that *is* his portion <02506>: for who shall bring him to see what shall be after him?
- Ecclesiastes 5:18 Behold *that* which I have seen: *it is* good and comely *for one* to eat and to drink, and to enjoy the good of all his labour that he taketh under the sun all the days of his life, which God giveth him: for it *is* his portion <02506>.
- Ecclesiastes 5:19 Every man also to whom God hath given riches and wealth, and hath given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion <02506>, and to rejoice in his labour; this *is* the gift of God.
- Ecclesiastes 9:6 Also their love, and their hatred, and their envy, is now perished; neither have they any more a portion <02506> for ever in any *thing* that is done under the sun.
- Ecclesiastes 9:9 Live joyfully with the wife whom thou lovest all the days of the life of thy vanity, which he hath given thee under the sun, all the days of thy vanity: for that *is* thy portion <02506> in *this* life, and in thy labour which thou takest under the sun.
- Ecclesiastes 11:2 Give a portion <02506> to seven, and also to eight; for thou knowest not what evil shall be upon the earth.
- Isaiah 17:14 And behold at eveningtide trouble; *and* before the morning he *is* not. This *is* the portion $\leq 0.02506 > 0$ of them that spoil us, and the lot of them that rob us.
- Isaiah 57:6 Among the smooth *stones* of the stream *is* thy portion <02506>; they, they *are* thy lot: even to them hast thou poured a drink offering, thou hast offered a meat offering. Should I receive comfort in these?
- Isaiah 61:7 For your shame *ye shall have* double; and *for* confusion they shall rejoice in their portion <02506>: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.
- Jeremiah 10:16 The portion $\leq 0.02506 \geq$ of Jacob *is* not like them: for he *is* the former of all *things*; and Israel *is* the rod of his inheritance: The LORD of hosts *is* his name.
- Jeremiah 51:19 The portion $\leq 0.02506 \geq$ of Jacob *is* not like them; for he *is* the former of all things: and *Israel is* the rod of his inheritance: the LORD of hosts *is* his name.
- Lamentations 3:24 The LORD *is* my portion <02506>, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.
- Ezekiel 45:7 And a *portion shall be* for the prince on the one side and on the other side of the oblation of the holy *portion*, and of the possession of the city, before the oblation of the holy *portion*, and before the possession of the city, from the west side westward, and from the east side eastward: and the length *shall be* over against one of the portions <0.2506>, from the west border unto the east border.
- Ezekiel 48:8 And by the border of Judah, from the east side unto the west side, shall be the offering which ye shall offer of five and twenty thousand *reeds in* breadth, and *in* length as one of the *other* parts <02506>, from the east side unto the west side: and the sanctuary shall be in the midst of it.
- Ezekiel 48:21 And the residue *shall be* for the prince, on the one side and on the other of the holy oblation, and of the possession of the city, over against the five and twenty thousand of the oblation toward the east border, and westward over against the five and twenty thousand toward the west border, over against the portions <0.2506> for the prince: and it shall be the holy oblation; and the sanctuary of the house *shall be* in the midst thereof.
- Hosea 5:7 They have dealt treacherously against the LORD: for they have begotten strange children: now shall a month devour them with their portions <0.2506>.
- Amos 7:4 Thus hath the Lord GOD shewed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part <02506>.

Micah 2:4 In that day shall *one* take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, *and* say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion <u><02506></u> of my people: how hath he removed *it* from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

27. Portion < 04490>

Portion is often translated the same as inheritance but it is a little different.

- Exodus 29:26 And thou shalt take the breast of the ram of Aaron's consecration, and wave it *for* a wave offering before the LORD: and it shall be thy part <0.4490>.
- Leviticus 7:33 He among the sons of Aaron, that offereth the blood of the peace offerings, and the fat, shall have the right shoulder for *his* part <04490>.
- Leviticus 8:29 And Moses took the breast, and waved it *for* a wave offering before the LORD: *for* of the ram of consecration it was Moses' part <04490>; as the LORD commanded Moses.
- 1 Samuel 1:4 And when the time was that Elkanah offered, he gave to Peninnah his wife, and to all her sons and her daughters, portions <04490>:
- 1 Samuel 1:5 But unto Hannah he gave a worthy portion <04490>; for he loved Hannah: but the LORD had shut up her womb.
- 1 Samuel 9:23 And Samuel said unto the cook, Bring the portion <04490> which I gave thee, of which I said unto thee, Set it by thee.
- 2 Chronicles 31:19 Also of the sons of Aaron the priests, *which were* in the fields of the suburbs of their cities, in every several city, the men that were expressed by name, to give portions to all the males among the priests, and to all that were reckoned by genealogies among the Levites.
- Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions <04490> unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for *this* day *is* holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
- Nehemiah 8:12 And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions <04490>, and to make great mirth, because they had understood the words that were declared unto them.
- Esther 2:9 And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged <04490> to her, and seven maidens, which were meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best place of the house of the women.
- Esther 9:19 Therefore the Jews of the villages, that dwelt in the unwalled towns, made the fourteenth day of the month Adar *a day of* gladness and feasting, and a good day, and of sending portions <04490> one to another.
- Esther 9:22 As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to joy, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and joy, and of sending portions <04490> one to another, and gifts to the poor.
- Psalms 16:5 The LORD is the portion <04490> of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.
- Jeremiah 13:25 This *is* thy lot, the portion <04490> of thy measures from me, saith the LORD; because thou hast forgotten me, and trusted in falsehood.

28. Cup <03563>

Genesis 40:11 And Pharaoh's cup <03563> was in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup <03563>, and I gave the cup <03563> into Pharaoh's hand.

- Genesis 40:13 Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup <03563> into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.
- Genesis 40:21 And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and he gave the cup ≤03563> into Pharaoh's hand:
- Leviticus $\overline{11:17}$ And the little owl $\underline{<03563>}$, and the cormorant, and the great owl, Deuteronomy 14:16 The little owl $\underline{<03563>}$, and the great owl, and the swan,
- 2 Samuel 12:3 But the poor *man* had nothing, save one little ewe lamb, which he had bought and nourished up: and it grew up together with him, and with his children; it did eat of his own meat, and drank of his own cup <03563>, and lay in his bosom, and was unto him as a daughter.
- 1 Kings 7:26 And it *was* an hand breadth thick, and the brim thereof was wrought like the brim of a cup <03563>, with flowers of lilies: it contained two thousand baths.
- 2 Chronicles 4:5 And the thickness of it *was* an handbreadth, and the brim of it like the work of the brim of a cup <03563>, with flowers of lilies; *and* it received and held three thousand baths.
- Psalms 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: *this shall be* the portion of their cup $\leq 0.3563 \geq$.
- Psalms 16:5 The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup $\leq 0.03563 \geq$: thou maintainest my lot.
- Psalms 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup <03563> runneth over.
- Psalms 75:8 For in the hand of the LORD *there is* a cup <03563>, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring *them* out, *and* drink *them*.
- Psalms 102:6 I am like a pelican of the wilderness: I am like an owl <03563> of the desert.
- Psalms 116:13 I will take the cup <03563> of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.
- Proverbs 23:31 Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup <03563>, when it moveth itself aright.
- Isaiah 51:17 Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup <03563> of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup <03563> of trembling, and wrung them out.
- Isaiah 51:22 Thus saith thy Lord the LORD, and thy God *that* pleadeth the cause of his people, Behold, I have taken out of thine hand the cup <u><03563></u> of trembling, *even* the dregs of the cup <u><03563></u> of my fury; thou shalt no more drink it again:
- Jeremiah 16:7 Neither shall *men* tear *themselves* for them in mourning, to comfort them for the dead; neither shall *men* give them the cup <03563> of consolation to drink for their father or for their mother.
- Jeremiah 25:15 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel unto me; Take the wine cup sold this fury at my hand, and cause all the nations, to whom I send thee, to drink it.
- Jeremiah 25:17 Then took I the cup <03563> at the LORD'S hand, and made all the nations to drink, unto whom the LORD had sent me:
- Jeremiah 25:28 And it shall be, if they refuse to take the cup <u><03563></u> at thine hand to drink, then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Ye shall certainly drink.
- Jeremiah 35:5 And I set before the sons of the house of the Rechabites pots full of wine, and cups <03563>, and I said unto them, Drink ye wine.
- Jeremiah 49:12 For thus saith the LORD; Behold, they whose judgment *was* not to drink of the cup <03563> have assuredly drunken; and *art* thou he *that* shall altogether go unpunished? thou shalt not go unpunished, but thou shalt surely drink *of it*.

- Jeremiah 51:7 Babylon *hath been* a golden cup <03563> in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are
- Lamentations 4:21 Rejoice and be glad, O daughter of Edom, that dwellest in the land of Uz; the cup <03563> also shall pass through unto thee: thou shalt be drunken, and shalt make thyself naked.
- Ezekiel 23:31 Thou hast walked in the way of thy sister; therefore will I give her cup <03563> into thine hand.
- Ezekiel 23:32 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou shalt drink of thy sister's cup <03563> deep and large: thou shalt be laughed to scorn and had in derision; it containeth much
- Ezekiel 23:33 Thou shalt be filled with drunkenness and sorrow, with the cup <03563> of astonishment and desolation, with the cup <03563> of thy sister Samaria.
- Habakkuk 2:16 Thou art filled with shame for glory: drink thou also, and let thy foreskin be uncovered: the cup <03563> of the LORD'S right hand shall be turned unto thee, and shameful spewing *shall be* on thy glory.

29. Banner <05251>

- Exodus 17:15 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it <u>Jehovahnissi</u>: 03071 yon hwhy Y@hovah nicciy *yeh-ho-vaw' nis-see' (Yahweh nec, same word for banner)*
- Numbers 21:8 And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole <05251>: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.
- Numbers 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole <05251>, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.
- Numbers 26:10 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with Korah, when that company died, what time the fire devoured two hundred and fifty men: and they became a sign <05251>.
- Psalms 60:4 Thou hast given a banner <05251> to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.
- Isaiah 5:26 And he will lift up an ensign <05251> to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:
- Isaiah 11:10 And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign $\leq 0.5251 \geq$ of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.
- Isaiah 11:12 And he shall set up an ensign <05251≥ for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.
- Isaiah 13:2 Lift ye up a banner <05251> upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.
- Isaiah 18:3 All ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth, see ye, when he lifteth up an ensign <05251> on the mountains; and when he bloweth a trumpet, hear ye.
- Isaiah 30:17 One thousand *shall flee* at the rebuke of one; at the rebuke of five shall ye flee: till ye be left as a beacon upon the top of a mountain, and as an ensign $\leq 0.05251 > 0.00$ on an hill.
- Isaiah 31:9 And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign <05251>, saith the LORD, whose fire *is* in Zion, and his furnace in Jerusalem.

- Isaiah 33:23 Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail <05251>: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey.
- Isaiah 49:22 Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up mine hand to the Gentiles, and set up my standard <05251≥ to the people: and they shall bring thy sons in *their* arms, and thy daughters shall be carried upon *their* shoulders.
- Isaiah 62:10 Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard $\leq 0.5251 \geq$ for the people.
- Jeremiah 4:6 Set up the standard <05251> toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.
- Jeremiah 4:21 How long shall I see the standard $\leq 0.5251 >$, and hear the sound of the trumpet?
- Jeremiah 50:2 Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard ; publish, *and* conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.
- Jeremiah 51:12 Set up the standard <05251> upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.
- Jeremiah 51:27 Set ye up a standard <05251> in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillers.
- Ezekiel 27:7 Fine linen with broidered work from Egypt was that which thou spreadest forth to be thy sail <05251>; blue and purple from the isles of Elishah was that which covered thee.

30. Song <02176>

- Exodus 15:2 The LORD *is* my strength and song <02176>, and he is become my salvation: he *is* my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.
- Psalms 118:14 The LORD *is* my strength and song <u><02176></u>, and is become my salvation.
- Isaiah 12:2 Behold, God *is* my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song $\leq 0.02176 \geq$; he also is become my salvation.

New Song

- Psalms 33:3 Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.
- Psalms 40:3 And he hath put a <u>new song</u> in my mouth, *even* praise unto our God: many shall see *it*, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.
- Psalms 96:1 O sing unto the LORD a <u>new song</u>: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.
- Psalms 98:1 <<A Psalm.>> O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.
- Psalms 144:9 I will sing a <u>new song</u> unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery *and* an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.
- Psalms 149:1 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a <u>new song</u>, *and* his praise in the congregation of saints.

31. Rock <05553>

There are 54 references to "rock" in the Old Testament. Again limiting your search to the name of the Lord, look for "my rock."

- Psalms 18:2 The LORD *is* my rock ≤05553>, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.
- Psalms 31:3 For thou *art* my rock <05553> and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.
- Psalms 40:2 He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock <05553>, and established my goings.
- Psalms 42:9 I will say unto God my rock <05553>, Why hast thou forgotten me? why go I mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?
- Psalms 71:3 Be thou my strong habitation, whereunto I may continually resort: thou hast given commandment to save me; for thou *art* my rock <05553> and my fortress.
- Psalms 78:16 He brought streams also out of the rock <05553>, and caused waters to run down like rivers.
- Psalms 104:18 The high hills *are* a refuge for the wild goats; *and* the rocks $\leq 0.5553 \geq 100$ for the conies.
- Psalms 137:9 Happy *shall he be*, that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones <05553>.
- Psalms 141:6 When their judges are overthrown in stony <05553> places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet.

32. Shepherd <07462>

There are 144 references to shepherds in the Old Testament and 13 in the New Testament

Still the Old Testament references to shepherd and shepherds are worth the time to study, especially Jeremiah, Ezekiel and Zechariah good examples of bad shepherds, contrast that to the Good Shepherd.

- Matthew 9:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no <u>shepherd</u>.
- Matthew 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a <u>shepherd</u> divideth *his* sheep from the goats:
- Matthew 26:31 Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the <u>shepherd</u>, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.
- Mark 6:34 And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a <u>shepherd</u>: and he began to teach them many things.
- Mark 14:27 And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.
- John 10:2 But he that entereth in by the door is the <u>shepherd</u> of the sheep.
- John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.
- John 10:12 But he that is an hireling, and not the <u>shepherd</u>, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.
- John 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

- John 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, *and* one <u>shepherd</u>.
- Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
- 1 Peter 2:25 For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the <u>Shepherd</u> and Bishop of your souls.
- 1 Peter 5:4 And when the chief <u>Shepherd</u> shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

33. Strength < 06697>

Sometimes it is translated "rock" it refers to the unmovable strength of the Lord. There are 74 such references. Limit your search to the Psalms and you get a good feel, but don't exclude the other passages. There are many Hebrew words for strength. (0386, 02392, 08510, 01679, 05797, 0202, 08443, 01369, **05331**, 04581 to name a few.)

- 2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my rock <06697>; in him will I trust: *he is* my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.
- 2 Samuel 22:32 For who *is* God, save the LORD? and who *is* a rock <06697>, save our God?
- 2 Samuel 22:47 The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock $\leq 06697 \geq$; and exalted be the God of the rock $\leq 06697 >$ of my salvation.
- Psalms 18:2 The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength <06697>, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.
- Psalms 18:31 For who *is* God save the LORD? or who *is* a rock <06697> save our God? Psalms 18:46 The LORD liveth; and blessed *be* my rock <06697>; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.
- Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength ≤06697>, and my redeemer.

35. Deliverer < 06403>

- 2 Samuel 22:2 And he said, The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer <06403>;
- 2 Samuel 22:44 Thou also hast delivered <06403> me from the strivings of my people, thou hast kept me *to be* head of the heathen: a people *which* I knew not shall serve me.
- Job 23:7 There the righteous might dispute with him; so should I be delivered $\leq 0.06403 \geq$ for ever from my judge.
- Psalms 17:13 Arise, O LORD, disappoint him, cast him down: deliver <06403> my soul from the wicked, which is thy sword:
- Psalms 18:2 The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer ≤06403>; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.

36. Goodness < 02617>

Goodness has 241 references in the Old Testament. It is translated mercy 149, kindness 40, lovingkindness 30, goodness 12, kindly 5, merciful 4, favour 3, good 1, goodliness 1, pity 1, and faithfulness. Search for God's character as "good."

- Exodus 15:13 Thou in thy mercy $\leq 0.02617 \geq$ hast led forth the people *which* thou hast redeemed: thou hast guided *them* in thy strength unto thy holy habitation.
- Exodus 20:6 And shewing mercy <02617> unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.
- Exodus 34:6 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness <02617> and truth,
- Exodus 34:7 Keeping mercy $\leq 0.2617 \geq$ for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear *the guilty*; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth *generation*.

37. Husband <01166>

- Genesis 20:3 But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou *art but* a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she *is* a man's wife <01166>.
- Deuteronomy 21:13 And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother a full month: and after

- that thou shalt go in unto her, and be her husband <01166>, and she shall be thy wife
- Deuteronomy 22:22 If a man be found lying with a woman married <01166> to an husband, then they shall both of them die, *both* the man that lay with the woman, and the woman: so shalt thou put away evil from Israel.
- Deuteronomy 24:1 When a man hath taken a wife, and married <01166> her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give *it* in her hand, and send her out of his house.
- 1 Chronicles 4:22 And Jokim, and the men of Chozeba, and Joash, and Saraph, who had the dominion <01166> in Moab, and Jashubilehem. And *these are* ancient things.
- Proverbs 30:23 For an odious *woman* when she is married <01166>; and an handmaid that is heir to her mistress.

- Isaiah 62:5 For as a young man marrieth }{2} a virgin, so shall thy sons marry \frac{01166>}{2} thee: and as the bridegroom rejoiceth over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee.
- Jeremiah 3:14 Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD; for I am married <01166> unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion:
- Jeremiah 31:32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband <01166> unto them, saith the LORD:
- Malachi 2:11 Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married <01166> the daughter of a strange god.

38. Redeemer < 01350>

Redeemer is also rendered kinsman redeemer.

- Genesis 48:16 The Angel which redeemed <01350> me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.
- Exodus 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem <01350> you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:
- Exodus 15:13 Thou in thy mercy hast led forth the people *which* thou hast redeemed <01350>: thou hast guided *them* in thy strength unto thy holy habitation.
- Leviticus 25:25 If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away *some* of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ it, then shall he redeem $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ that which his brother sold.

- Leviticus 25:26 And if the man have none to redeem <01350> it, and himself be able to redeem it:
- Leviticus 25:30 And if it be not redeemed <01350> within the space of a full year, then the house that *is* in the walled city shall be established for ever to him that bought it throughout his generations: it shall not go out in the jubile.
- Leviticus 25:33 And if a man purchase $\leq 01350 \geq$ of the Levites, then the house that was sold, and the city of his possession, shall go out in *the year of* jubile: for the houses of the cities of the Levites *are* their possession among the children of Israel.
- Leviticus 25:48 After that he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his brethren may redeem <01350> him:
- Leviticus 25:49 Either his uncle, or his uncle's son, may redeem $\leq 0.1350 > \text{him}$, or any that is nigh of kin unto him of his family may redeem $\leq 0.1350 > \text{him}$; or if he be able, he may redeem $\leq 0.1350 > \text{himself}$.
- Leviticus 25:54 And if he be not redeemed $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ in these *years*, then he shall go out in the year of jubile, *both* he, and his children with him.
- Leviticus 27:13 But if he will at all $\leq 01350 >$ redeem $\leq 01350 >$ it, then he shall add a fifth *part* thereof unto thy estimation.
- Leviticus 27:15 And if he that sanctified it will redeem $\leq 01350 >$ his house, then he shall add the fifth *part* of the money of thy estimation unto it, and it shall be his.
- Leviticus 27:19 And if he that sanctified the field will in any wise <01350> redeem <01350> it, then he shall add the fifth *part* of the money of thy estimation unto it, and it shall be assured to him.
- Leviticus 27:20 And if he will not redeem <01350> the field, or if he have sold the field to another man, it shall not be redeemed <01350> any more.
- Leviticus 27:27 And if *it be* of an unclean beast, then he shall redeem *it* according to thine estimation, and shall add a fifth *part* of it thereto: or if it be not redeemed <01350>, then it shall be sold according to thy estimation.
- Leviticus 27:28 Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the LORD of all that he hath, *both* of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed <01350>: every devoted thing *is* most holy unto the LORD.
- Leviticus 27:31 And if a man will at all $\leq 0.1350 > \text{redeem} \leq 0.1350 > ought$ of his tithes, he shall add thereto the fifth *part* thereof.
- Leviticus 27:33 He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed <01350>.
- Numbers 5:8 But if the man have no kinsman <01350> to recompense the trespass unto, let the trespass be recompensed unto the LORD, *even* to the priest; beside the ram of the atonement, whereby an atonement shall be made for him.
- Numbers 35:12 And they shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger ≤ 0.1350 ; that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation in judgment.
- Numbers 35:19 The revenger <01350> of blood himself shall slay the murderer: when he meeteth him, he shall slay him.
- Numbers 35:21 Or in enmity smite him with his hand, that he die: he that smote *him* shall surely be put to death; *for* he *is* a murderer: the revenger <01350> of blood shall slay the murderer, when he meeteth him.
- Numbers 35:24 Then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the revenger <01350> of blood according to these judgments:
- Numbers 35:25 And the congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger <01350> of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of the high priest, which was anointed with the holy oil.
- Numbers 35:27 And the revenger $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of blood:

- Deuteronomy 19:6 Lest the avenger <01350> of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he was not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past.
- Deuteronomy 19:12 Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger <01350> of blood, that he may die.
- Joshua 20:3 That the slayer that killeth *any* person unawares *and* unwittingly may flee thither: and they shall be your refuge from the avenger <01350> of blood.
- Joshua 20:5 And if the avenger <01350> of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote his neighbour unwittingly, and hated him not beforetime.
- Joshua 20:9 These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them, that whosoever killeth *any* person at unawares might flee thither, and not die by the hand of the avenger <01350> of blood, until he stood before the congregation.

- Ruth 3:9 And he said, Who *art* thou? And she answered, I *am* Ruth thine handmaid: spread therefore thy skirt over thine handmaid; for thou *art* a near kinsman <01350>.
- Ruth 3:12 And now it is true that I *am thy* near kinsman <01350>: howbeit there is a kinsman <01350> nearer than I.
- Ruth 3:13 Tarry this night, and it shall be in the morning, *that* if he will perform unto thee the part of a kinsman $\leq 01350 \geq$, well; let him do the kinsman's part $\leq 01350 \geq$: but if he will not do the part of a kinsman $\leq 01350 \geq$ to thee, then will I do the part of a kinsman $\leq 01350 \geq$ to thee, *as* the LORD liveth: lie down until the morning.
- Ruth 4:1 Then went Boaz up to the gate, and sat him down there: and, behold, the kinsman <01350> of whom Boaz spake came by; unto whom he said, Ho, such a one! turn aside, sit down here. And he turned aside, and sat down.
- Ruth 4:3 And he said unto the kinsman <01350>, Naomi, that is come again out of the country of Moab, selleth a parcel of land, which was our brother Elimelech's:
- Ruth 4:4 And I thought to advertise thee, saying, Buy it before the inhabitants, and before the elders of my people. If thou wilt redeem $\leq 01350 \geq it$, redeem $\leq 01350 \geq it$ but if thou wilt not redeem $\leq 01350 \geq it$, then tell me, that I may know: for there is none to redeem $\leq 01350 \geq it$ beside thee; and I am after thee. And he said, I will redeem $\leq 01350 \geq it$.
- Ruth 4:6 And the kinsman $\leq 0.01350 \geq \text{said}$, I cannot redeem $\leq 0.01350 \geq it$ for myself, lest I mar mine own inheritance: redeem $\leq 0.01350 \geq it$ thou my right to thyself; for I cannot redeem $\leq 0.01350 \geq it$.
- Ruth 4:8 Therefore the kinsman $\leq 0.01350 >$ said unto Boaz, Buy it for thee. So he drew off his shoe.
- Ruth 4:14 And the women said unto Naomi, Blessed *be* the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman <01350>, that his name may be famous in Israel.
- 2 Samuel 14:11 Then said she, I pray thee, let the king remember the LORD thy God, that thou wouldest not suffer the revengers <01350> of blood to destroy any more, lest they destroy my son. And he said, *As* the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of thy son fall to the earth.
- 1 Kings 16:11 And it came to pass, when he began to reign, as soon as he sat on his throne, *that* he slew all the house of Baasha: he left him not one that pisseth against a wall, neither of his kinsfolks <01350>, nor of his friends.

- Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer <01350>.
- Psalms 69:18 Draw nigh unto my soul, *and* redeem <01350> it: deliver me because of mine enemies.
- Psalms 72:14 He shall redeem <01350> their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.
- Psalms 74:2 Remember thy congregation, *which* thou hast purchased of old; the rod of thine inheritance, *which* thou hast redeemed <01350>; this mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt.
- Psalms 77:15 Thou hast with *thine* arm redeemed <01350> thy people, the sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.
- Psalms 78:35 And they remembered that God was their rock, and the high God their redeemer <01350>.

- Isaiah 35:9 No lion shall be there, nor *any* ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there; but the redeemed $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ shall walk *there*:

- Isaiah 44:6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer $\leq 0.1350 \geq$ the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.
- Isaiah 44:22 I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed <01350> thee.
- Isaiah 44:23 Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done *it*: shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for the LORD hath redeemed <01350> Jacob, and glorified himself in Israel.
- Isaiah 44:24 Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer <01350>, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

We are looking for the word "restore." There are 937 references to that word.

- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth <07725> my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- Psalms 51:12 <u>Restore</u> unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.

- Psalms 126:1 When the LORD turned again <07725> the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.
- Psalms 126:4 Turn again ≤07725> our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south. Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, *saying*, This *is* Zion, whom no man seeketh after.
- Joel 2:25 And <u>I</u> will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpiller, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.

- Genesis 30:18 And Leah said, God hath given me my hire <07939>, because I have given my maiden to my husband: and she called his name Issachar.
- Genesis 30:28 And he said, Appoint me thy wages ≤ 0.7939 , and I will give it.
- Genesis 30:32 I will pass through all thy flock to day, removing from thence all the speckled and spotted cattle, and all the brown cattle among the sheep, and the spotted and speckled among the goats: and *of such* shall be my hire <07939>.
- Genesis 30:33 So shall my righteousness answer for me in time to come, when it shall come for my hire $\leq 0.07939 >$ before thy face: every one that *is* not speckled and spotted among the goats, and brown among the sheep, that shall be counted stolen with me.

- Deuteronomy 15:18 It shall not seem hard unto thee, when thou sendest him away free from thee; for he hath been worth <07939> a double hired servant *to thee*, in serving thee six years: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all that thou doest.

- Zechariah 8:10 For before these days there was no hire <0.07939> for man, nor any hire <0.07939> for beast; neither was there any peace to him that went out or came in because of the affliction: for I set all men every one against his neighbour.
