

KNOW HIM AND HIS NAME

Charles Spurgeon, the great prince of preachers, once articulated the need and importance of studying the names, titles and character of God the Father and Jesus Christ His Son:

"Nothing will so enlarge the intellect, nothing so magnify the whole soul of man, as a devout, earnest, continued investigation of the great subject of the Deity. The most excellent study for expanding the soul is the science of Christ and him crucified and the knowledge of the Godhead in the glorious Trinity. The proper study of the Christian is the Godhead. The highest science, the loftiest speculation, the mightiest philosophy, which can engage the attention of a child of God, is the name, the nature, the person, the doings, and the existence of the Great God which he calls his Father... It is a subject so vast, that all our thoughts are lost in its immensity; so deep, that our pride is drowned in its infinity. Other subjects we can comprehend and grapple with; in them we feel a kind of self-content, and our way with the thought, 'Behold I am wise.' But when we come to this master science, finding that our plumbline cannot sound its depth, and that our eagle eye cannot see its height, we turn away with the thought, 'I am but of yesterday and know nothing."

The Apostle Paul declared his life-long purpose was *"To know him in the power of the resurrection."* (Philippians 3:8-11) He goes on to challenge the church in every place to make this their purpose and goal – to know Him and make Him known.

Knowing About God is Not Knowing God

Knowing God is not just an intellectual pursuit. To know him as the Apostle Paul expressed it is to know him intimately and personally in every facet of His being – to know Him in the power of His resurrection.

Paul urged us to *"Fix our eyes on Jesus the author and finisher of our faith."* (Hebrews 12:2) He tells the Corinthians that,

"We, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." (2 Cor. 3:18)

God's Identification Papers

We learn who He is through the Word and through His expression of himself in His multi-faceted names. His name is His I.D., His identification papers, His photo I.D. that represents the exact image of His person.

Seeing God's Face

It is clear from Scripture in Exodus 34 that God's face cannot be seen at any time by us humans, although Moses was permitted on one occasion to see God's back side as he passed by. God commanded the people of Israel to not make graven images depicting Jehovah at any time.

We Have No Picture of Jesus

The Apostle exhorts us to *"fix our eyes on Jesus."* (Hebrews 12:1-2) Yet we know we cannot really fix our eyes on Jesus. We have no drawing, painting, sculpture or exact image of what he looked like.

Early church history records there was but one such drawing of Jesus, perhaps just a sketch, made by a King Agbar's secretary, who was sent to request Jesus to visit his master and heal him of his leprosy. That secretary sketched the likeness of Jesus that was subsequently duplicated and distributed among the churches. It was found in the archives of the Church of Edessa many years later. That image survives today.

A Roman Description of Jesus

The only other likeness of Jesus was an alleged letter written by Publius who describes the features of Jesus...

"Lentulus, the Governor of the Jerusalemites to the Roman Senate and People, greetings. There has appeared in our times, and there still lives, a man of great power (virtue), called Jesus Christ. The people call him prophet of truth; his disciples, son of God. He raises the dead, and heals infirmities. He is a man of medium size and handsome; he has a venerable aspect, and his beholders can both fear and love him. His hair is of the color of the ripe hazelnut, straight down to the ears, but below the ears wavy and curled, with a bluish and bright reflection, flowing over his shoulders. It is parted in two on the top of the head, after the pattern of the Nazarenes. His brow is smooth and very cheerful with a face without wrinkle or spot. embellished by a slightly reddish complexion. His nose and mouth are faultless. His beard is abundant, of the color of his hair, not long, but divided at the chin. His aspect is simple and mature; his eyes are changeable and bright. He is terrible in his reprimands, sweet and amiable in his admonitions, cheerful without loss of gravity. He was never known to laugh, but often to weep. His stature is straight, his hands and arms beautiful to behold. His conversation is grave, infrequent, and modest. He is the most beautiful among the children of men."

<u>Biblical Portraits of God the Father and Jesus Christ His Son</u> The Bible tells us that Jesus is the exact image of the Father, the exact representation of his person. The Apostle John says Jesus Christ declares the Father to us. (John 1:14 & 18)

"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth...No one has ever seen God, but God the One and Only, who is at the Father's side, has made him known."

God Drew Us a Picture of Himself

God drew a picture of himself in sending His Son, Jesus, to live and walk among us. We see Jesus through the Word of God. Our only way of knowing him intimately and personally is through studying his character and person as conveyed to us in the Bible. The person of God the Father and Jesus Christ the Son is conveyed to us also through his multifaceted names God left for us scattered throughout the Biblical Text. They are like the fingerprints of God left behind for us to discover. There are over 700 names, titles, descriptors, personifications and analogies of God and Christ in the Scriptures.

<u>A Hidden Treasure</u>

God left us a treasure chest of rich descriptions of himself because He wants us to know all of Him, not just a part. He does not want us to be satisfied to know him just as Savior, nor just as our Healer, or just as our Sanctifier, and our Coming King. He is so much more! He wants every believer to know Him in all His glory, to know Him in His resurrection power. By knowing Him we can experience Him. We can reach out and embrace who He says He wants to be to us.

This booklet is an attempt to help you in the process of knowing God and Jesus Christ in all his splendor and glory by discovering His wonderful names and characteristics.

We have listed here in a note card format over 200 names that clearly describe the Lord to us. God invites you to embrace those names as who He wants to be in your life and experience.

- Do you know him as your...Deliverer?
- Do you know him as your...Friend?
- Do you know him as your...Healer?

Every name God has recorded to describe himself in the Word of God is for you to experience Him in that way. The following cards containing those names are given to you so that you may lay hold of the name, the person, and the work of the Father and the Son, and to be like Jesus.

HOW TO USE THIS BOOKLET

James warns us to "be not hearers of the word only deceiving ourselves, but be doers of the word." Just reading or hearing the names of the Lord is of little value. We must put His name to good use.

- 1) <u>Study</u> each of the names and what God tells us about himself. Join with others in the study of His names.
- 2) <u>Pray</u> each of the names, taking hold of the hem of His garment and refusing to let go until His glory flows in to your experientially.
- 3) <u>Adopt</u> one or more of His names to claim and cling to all through a month or a year until it becomes indelibly imprinted on your heart and life.
- 4) <u>Share</u> with others what the Lord has come to mean to you through His names. Show them what God has revealed to you about himself in His word.

There are 31 pages, one for each day of the month, and 10 Names of the Lord to contemplate and experience. Use them. Don't just read them. They are not for hanging on the walls as a plaque, but they are names to be experienced.

Pick one each day for the next ten months. Choose one of the ten each day and ask the Lord to be that for you on that particular day. Hold it close to your heart. Pray it. Claim it and cling to it with all your heart. God already is that to you. He waits to be embraced.

More Than a Benediction

We often get into a habit of doing something or saying something so often that we forget its original meanings. This passage from Numbers 6 is and everlasting injunction to the priests of God that is to be as significant as the Passover or Communion is to us today. It is not just a pretty poetical saying for dismissing a congregation to go home. It was never meant to be trite or trivial. It was a very real prayer and pronouncement to be given over God's people. Remember, Peter says, we are a KINGDOM OF PRIESTS. We are to be praying priests who pronounce this blessing over the people of God. It comes with a promise – They will put my name of them, AND I WILL BLESS THEM.

This means they will be marked for blessing by the Spirit of God. How encouraging it has been to people in our churches when we God's children pray this prayer over one another with our left hand raised to heaven and our right hand laid on them. We are touching the Throne of Grace on behalf of another and in the authority given to us by the Word of God and blood of Christ **they will be blessed!**

NUMBERS 6:26-27

This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them:

"The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace."'

> So they will <u>put my name on</u> the Israelites, and <u>I will bless them</u>.

Adopt Embrace Claim the Name

In closing I want to encourage you to put the Name of the Lord into practice. For many years now we have taught our congregations to look prayerfully for a Name of the Lord that God wants you to carry with you into the coming year. We usually start around October pouring over the various Names the Lord has revealed to us and choosing a final three to consider. During the Christmas season we finally settle on THE NAME that the Lord has chosen for us to adopt, embrace, and claim as our own during the coming year. Then we share that name with other people, sometimes in private converstations, sometimes in public testimony, but always as an ornament with His Name that we place on the Christmas Tree.
